Facilitator for the **Anti-Defamation League, A World of Difference Institute**.

Reverend Rhetta is very active in the Philadelphia area, using **music she writes and sings to inspire and heal**. Along with ministerial work at Ecclesia, she recently performed for the Leeway + Bread and Roses Town Hall on Incarceration and Gender, using her voice to create inclusive sacred space. Reverend Rhetta performs and works with Girls Rock Philadelphia, an organization that supports and empowers girls and young women. She has worked with EQAT and Philly Thrive as both musical leader and spiritual anchor. Also, she has worked with Penn student organizers around PILOTS. Rev Rhetta has facilitated music for MAYPOP, The New Economy Coalition and Protecting Our Waters.

Some of Rev. Rhetta's most meaningful work is **mentoring and counseling activist leaders** in our area, encouraging self-care and what she calls a spiritual tool box to aid against despair, overwhelm and depression.
