Kate performs with violin, guitar, and vocals and crosses genres from Classical to Americana/Folk.

Kate will be joined by special guest musicians.

Kate MacLeod is an award-winning songwriter and instrumentalist performing throughout the United States and Europe, often donating her music to environmental and social justice activities. Other artists have recorded her music in Celtic, Bluegrass, and other Roots Music genres. Originally from the Washington D.C. area, Kate now resides in Salt Lake City, UT, where she is a member of the Salt Lake Quaker Monthly Meeting.
