



## Sing with the Pendle Hill Chorus!

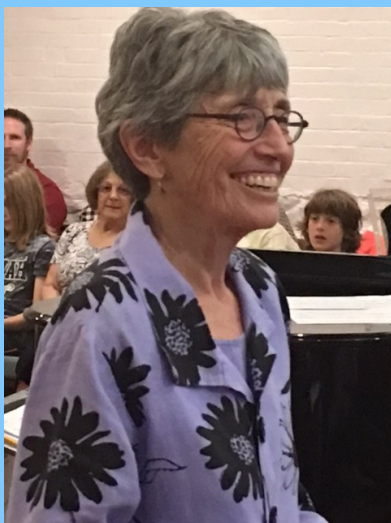
